Helping Women Succeed



Resonance proudly provides the following services:



Prison-To-Community Reentry Services*

Resonance provides services in every female Department of Corrections facility in the state of Oklahoma. These services range from mentoring and reentry planning to educational classes and addiction treatment. The goal is for women to successfully release with the tools needed to maintain their sobriety, to be gainfully employed and to reunite with their children.

Substance Abuse Treatment and **Diversion Services**

Women are referred to Resonance for outpatient substance abuse treatment, often times in lieu of serving prison time. Outpatient treatment varies from three months to three years, during which time participants live and work in the community, caring for their children and learning to cope with everyday life stressors throughout their recovery journey.

Take 2: A Resonance Café

To help further combat the barriers existing for women releasing from prison, Resonance operates Take 2: A Resonance Café to offer a safe, positive and educational work and living environment for women transitioning out of prison. The café at 309 South Main in downtown Tulsa and the upstairs loft provide stable housing and employment, enabling at-risk women the opportunity to establish a positive work history and improve life and work skills.


